EARLY SIGNS OF A VISUAL IMPAIRMENT:

- White or greyish color in pupil
- Infant older than 3 months is unable to track objects in their field of vision or make steady eye contact
- Eyes that flutter quickly from side to side or up and down
- Drooping eyelids
- Light sensitivity

OTHER RISK FACTORS:

- Babies who experienced birth trauma
- Babies with birth defects like hydrocephaly, microcephaly, ophthalmia, coloboma
- Neurological impairment



PROGRAMS

EARLY INTERVENTION AGES 0-3

Helps children overcome early obstacles posed by visual impairments and meet key development milestones.

- Early intervention and vision stimulation
- Occupational, Physical, and Speech therapy services
- Infant/Toddler classrooms



EDUCATION + ENRICHMENT AGES 3-22

Accelerates academic success, enriches social development, and helps develop key life and daily living skills.

- Instruction with a Teacher of the Visually Impaired (TVI)
- Braille training and other low vision learning modalities
- Orientation & Mobility training
- Inclusive summer camps
- Peer groups
- Access to assistive technology and training

FAMILY SUPPORT

Resources help families thrive and gain confidence.

- Guidance through the student's Journey of Care
- Assistive technology training
- Parent education and training
- Wellness line and checks


Services are offered onsite at our facilities in North Tustin, virtually, in schools throughout Orange County, and home-based for qualifying families.
