Learning Link Participation Guidelines

- Learning Link is for children aged 0-5 years old accompanied by an adult.
- Learning Link is an interactive program. Adults accompanying a child are expected and encouraged to participate and interact with them.
- One parent may attend Learning Link with no more than two children. Parents unable to engage with both children may be asked to leave and return with another adult.
- The infant corner is set aside for infants and adults. Please help maintain cleanliness by not allowing older children to walk or play on the mat. No shoes should be worn on the mat.
- To ensure the safety of all children, participants will be asked to use their “walking feet” inside the classroom. Jumping and running are not allowed in the classroom.
- Please be aware that some objects in our center may not be age appropriate for your child. Please closely monitor your child and their activities to ensure their safety.
- Parents and children should put away toys, books, and materials before moving on to another activity. This is a wonderful time to instruct your child about cleaning up while practicing sorting and organizational skills.
- Please use, and encourage your child to use, kind words in the classroom. This is an opportunity to teach your child how to solve problems in a positive way.
- Hitting and throwing objects will not be permitted. An age-appropriate consequence will be given for negative behavior.
- Please leave personal books and toys at home. This is an opportunity to introduce your child to new toys and activities.
- No food or beverages inside the classroom.
- No cell phone use.
- Any parent unable to supervise their child(ren) may be asked to leave and return another day.
