Position Summary:

The Classroom Teacher position plans and implements daily lesson plans and activities for children with visual impairments and developmental delays 6 months to 3 years old. Keeps ongoing assessment of each child's remedial, behavioral and adaptive progress with documentation.

This job description is intended as a guide to the general job responsibilities.

Tasks and Activities

- Develops, plans, and implements daily lesson plans and activities. Prepares monthly activity calendar.
- Attends to health, safety, and hygiene of children.
- Assists with toileting, bathroom and diaper needs.
- Maintains timely and accurate documentation of assessments, individualized plans, attendance, daily health checklist, feedings, daily activity logs for parents, home visits,

inventories, and other documentation as may be deemed necessary for proving quality services.

- Conducts ongoing assessments of infants and toddlers to determine motor, language, social, cognitive perceptual and emotional skills.
- Maintains regular communication with parents.
- Treats clients, families and others with empathy and respect and conduct self in a professional manner
- Participates in training, supervision, and meetings.
- Complies with organizational guidelines and HIPAA health care laws and regulations.
- Conducts self in accordance with Agency's mission, vision, and values at all times.
- Other professional, job-related duties as assigned.

- Current up-to-date Credential, License, Certification or Units for employment
